

ARTICLE V. BICYCLES

Sec. 34-116. Operation on sidewalks and paths.

No bicycle shall be operated upon any public sidewalk in the business district, in any congested commercial area, or upon any pedestrian paths in the public parks.

Sec. 34-117. Speed or endurance contest.

No person operating a bicycle upon a street or public highway shall participate in any race, speed or endurance contest with any other vehicle.

Sec. 34-118. Acrobatic riding prohibited.

No rider of a bicycle shall remove both hands from the handlebars, or feet from the pedals, or practice acrobatic or fancy riding on any street or public highway.

Sec. 34-119. Use of coaster, roller skates or similar devices restricted.

No person upon roller skates, or riding in or by means of any coaster, toy vehicle or similar device shall go upon any roadway except while crossing a street or a crosswalk and except upon streets set aside for that purpose.

Sec. 34-120. Towing coasters, sleds and toy vehicles.

The operator of any vehicle shall not tow or draw any coaster, sled, person on roller skates, toy vehicle or other similar vehicle on a roadway.
